

Protecting Your Privacy

The Federal Personal Information Protection and Electronics Documents Act came into effect on January 1st, 2004.

Personal information is any information that could specifically identify an individual. Examples include your name, address, and telephone number.

We collect personal information through our membership application form. When you complete this form, you consent to our collection, use, retention, and disclosure of your information for the following purposes:

- To notify you of our annual meetings and any other meetings called by the Board of Directors;
- To mail out newsletters and any information deemed necessary by the board of Directors;
- To telephone you regarding events and/or fund raisers Friends of Birds Hill Park and/or Birds Hill Provincial Park have organized.

Access to this personal information will be limited to the Board of Directors and members authorized by the Board to do telephoning and mail outs.

We will assume that we have your consent for the continued use of your personal information for purposes described above.
